Two meter foxhunting in Chicago started in the early 1960s. One of the first hunts started on 147.30 MHz. The starting point was in Des Plaines near the Centel Building. With the introduction of 2 meter repeaters, it moved to the CFAR repeater. There were hunts on the WAFAR, ACL and CFMC repeaters with a simplex hunt sponsored by the RAMS on 146.34 MHz. Now the lineup is on CFAR, CMFC and two simplex hunts.

John WD9EXW got the three hunt teams off with a strong signal to the SE. The hunters headed south on Rt 83. Tom was right along with us as Matt chose 22nd St to head west. We had a strong signal ahead of us and maybe to the north of 22nd. We went too far and went back to a number of tall buildings just north of Butterfield Rd. Even though the temp was in the upper 30s, there was still lots of snow on the ground. I spotted John K9JK in a clearing east of us when we parked on Tower Pl. I headed in the wrong direction as Matt drove around to Renaissance Blvd to find John inside a cement pipe with his antenna sticking out. Pete and John got there for the win 7 minutes earlier. I came back to witness Tom going in to find John to end the hunt. Matt called Jacob and Mac to find "Grandpa". We went to The Patio nearby. Results:















2nd Sat 2M Foxhunt - Feb 9th, 2019 by Mike WA9FTS

They tried to find us from various directions such as Vally View Rd off Army Trail Rd. They all drove away to try other approaches. They were only 500 ft away from the end of the road to us. - 3. Tony AA9CC 9:14PM 1 hr 15 min





Pete and Tony walked in from the north to find us.




Our original hiding spot

John WD9EXW and Janet joined us at Portillo's




CFMC 2M Foxhunt - Feb 16th, 2019 - by Mike WA9FTS
