Two meter foxhunting in Chicago started in the early 1960s. One of the first hunts started on 147.30 MHz. The starting point was in Des Plaines near the Centel Building. With the introduction of 2 meter repeaters, it moved to the CFAR repeater. There were hunts on the WAFAR, ACL and CFMC repeaters with a simplex hunt sponsored by the RAMS on 146.34 MHz. Now the lineup is on CFAR, CMFC and two simplex hunts.



I found a gravel road south off Irving Park Rd and Taft which was the road north to the US Post Office for O"Hare Airport. It could not be easily seen from Irving Park Rd. I drove back and behind a small hill and waited for the 4 hunt teams to find me. I found out late in the hunt that Matt, Patty and the kids got back home earlier in the day and were hunting unofficially. With all the hunters hearing me we got the hunters started at 8:04PM.

























34 2M Foxhunt - Aug 25th, 2018 by Mike WA9FTS


