Now the lineup is on CFAR, CMFC and two simplex hunts.






# **Chicagoland Foxhunters Report**

#### CFMC 2M Foxhunt - Aug 21st, 2021 by Mike WA9FTS


















34 2M Foxhunt - Aug 28th, 2021 by Mike WA9FTS - Fox Tony AA9CC


