Two meter foxhunting in Chicago started in the early 1960s. One of the first hunts started on 147.30 MHz. The starting point was in Des Plaines near the Centel Building. With the introduction of 2 meter repeaters, it moved to the CFAR repeater. There were hunts on the WAFAR, ACL and CFMC repeaters with a simplex hunt sponsored by the RAMS on 146.34 MHz. Now the lineup is on CFAR, CMFC and two simplex hunts.



CFAR 2M Foxhunt - Aug 5th, 2023 by Tom N9CBA

It had rained much of the day, but was clearing. Tom N9CBA was prepared to hide out of the car, but renewed sprinkles triggered the hide in the car. Hide spot was at coordinates 41.75031 -87.87515.

The antenna was a 3-ele tape measure beam driven by 10 watts. The antenna was mostly horizontal and only 4 or 5 ft up, but aimed at trying to get a good bounce from the upper part of the nearby squat water tower/tank. Signal was weak at the starting point.

Jacob ran some to get to the fox, which they had spotted. Clearly they took the optimum route -- south on 83, and west on Plainfield Road. I also suspect the transmission happened to hit at a very fortunate time. John and Janet took a similar route but probably did not luck out as much for the transmission.

Marty was hunting Don-style (no outside antenna-- stop and take readings with the portable gear), so his was quite good. New Tesla Y for Marty. Roof rack may or may not be feasible. Let's see.

Don was also hunting Don-style. :-)












Marty was on a new bridge crossing Eola Rd. It was just south of his home in Oswego.






34 2M Foxhunt - Aug 26th, 2023 by Pete K9PW

Six teams of hunts were present for the last foxhunt in August. On a pleasant evening, the hounds are released at 8:05PM. All teams easily heard the fox. Some reported a level two on their sniffers. The fox was using 40 Watts to a quarter wave antenna located 15' above the surrounding area.

The fox (Pete, K9PW) was located on a dirt pile at the former location of the main design & manufacturing building of Motorola. Ten years ago, the fox's office had been located less than 200' away in that now demolished building. The site is now being converted to half million dollar townhouses. The location was seven miles from the start. Optimum driving route was 10 miles in just over 15 minutes. The first two cars were seen in the area in just 20 minutes. Fox location = N42.06685 W88.04843. Munch was at the Donkey Inn located in Palatine.
