Now the lineup is on CFAR, CMFC and two simplex hunts.




















This is an overhead view of where John hid. The only reason for it was to have a place off the drive in back of the stores for the fire plug.



David arrive before Don to start the hunt.


34 2M Foxhunt - Sep 26th, 2020 by Mike WA9FTS - Fox John WD9EXW and Janet




