TREASURER'S REPORT. The club is solvent. (Just before the annual party, solvency is good!) For club members, Treasurer Mike Brost WA9FTS will present details to at our next business meeting.

ELECTIONS. The club votes unanimously to reelect the present officers.

TONIGHT'S PROGRAM is the fall auction. We don't exactly have record traffic. Yet the proceeds will enable the club to buy a new piece of foam rubber. Perhaps you'll bid on it someday. That's Exit 57 (57 miles from lowa), or 75-miles from I-55! (We await reception reports from Uranus, Saturn, Jupiter and Mars.)

DECEMBER PARTY. To discuss the party location, the board met on November 11. As of this writing, the party will convene at Old Warsaw Buffet. (The one at 4750 N Harlem Avenue, Harwood Heights, IL 60706.) There will a \$5.00 charge.

SEO FOR OUR WEB SITE. Our club Web site needs some basic SEO (search engine optimization). Secretary Jim Hawes AA9DT will send Mike Brost the code for a Facebook "Like" button. (On November 19, Jim sends Mike the code.)

WINDOWS 10 DRIVERS. Mike Leibovitz WA9EVF fields questions about his Microsoft Windows presentation at the last general meeting. Jean Pressel KB9FXL is considering an upgrade to Windows 10. Her system includes peripherals that might become obsolete after the upgrade. She asks about peripheral drivers for Windows 10. Mike provides some very reassuring news: Windows 10 uses the same drivers as in Windows 7! Mike's own video board uses a generic driver that Microsoft provides.

MORE ABOUT WINDOWS 10 UPGRADES. The download for the Windows 10 upgrade takes most of one day. (That is, with the typical Internet service and network settings of 2015.) Before one can perform the installation, Microsoft requires a few prerequisites: Your CPU *must* be capable of running three special instructions. (One of the instructions is 'SSE,' an Intel single streaming extension.) Also before attempting the upgrade, load all Windows upgrades for your OS (Windows 7 or 8).


COPYING HARD DRIVES. These notes are from our board meeting on November 11. WA9EVF summarized how to copy a Windows hard disc to a larger hard disc.

MIKE RECOMMENDS using EaseUS Backup Mirror software. This product is a free download. (See http://www.easeus.com/download/free-software.html). Here are the steps to follow: [1.] Create a bootable CD or DVD. (CAUTION: Use a *single-layer* DVD.) [2.] Boot off the CD or DVD. [3.] Clone the drive sector by sector. [4.] Hook up the drive with SATA-to-USB converter (including a microcontroller and power supply). [5.] Optional: As insurance, store your old drive in an off-site safe. [6.] Optional: If you use a disc for one redundant backup, Mike recommends RAID 1 recovery software by EaseUS. (For greater than one disc, substitute RAID 5. For ten drives, use RAID 6.)

Astronomers look to Titan for clouds, haze, & E.T.

The onset of winter is bringing big changes to the southern hemisphere of Saturn's largest moon, Titan. In May 2012, the Cassini spacecraft's camera captured a cloud system rising 185 miles (300 kilometers) above the moon's south pole, where sunlight

barely illuminated it. Although the Sun has now set over the region, ice clouds still exist there. At the 46th annual meeting of the Division for Planetary Sciences in National Harbor, Maryland, Carrie Anderson of NASA's Goddard Space Flight Center reported on her discovery of a new cloud feature closer to the surface.


